Purpose

This document describes the process of installing the database drivers. These instructions are also included in the Common Setup Instructions but are provided here in case the drivers need to be re-applied or updated after the Common Setup Instructions have been completed.

Before you begin

Make sure that no one is using the computer where you are installing the database drivers.

Make sure no other programs are running.

Starting the Database Driver Setup

Insert the ePower CD in your CD drive. Choose Start – Run and then browse. Browse to your CD drive and double click the Common folder. Double click the MDAC_TYP.EXE program.

Follow the on-screen instructions to install the database driver.

Re-boot your computer when the database driver setup completes.

Installing the Access Drivers

The database driver requires two steps to complete. After re-booting your computer, return to Start – Run and browse. Browse to your CD drive and double click the Common folder. Double click the JET40SP3_COMP.EXE program.

Follow the on-screen instructions to install the database drivers.

Re-boot your computer when the database driver setup completes.
